ARP Funds Sunset

Summary of the ARP Timeline:

- In 2021, the American Rescue Plan appropriated 800 million to close the academic gaps for McKinney Vento students caused during the COVID-19 pandemic
- ARP funds must be obligated by September 30, 2024, and liquidated by January 28, 2025.
- States can apply to extend the liquidation of ARP-HCY funds
 - o This extends the liquidation period to March 2026
 - o Additional information is linked on the NAEHCY to the US ED Summary and presentation

Changing Landscape - Prepare for Impact

- Budget cuts around identification, awareness, and support of homeless children and youth.
- Possible barriers to full participation in educational activities
- Possible ARP-supported resource gaps
- Staff reductions
- Decreased mental health supports
- Reduced funding to close academic gaps
- Reduced Early Childhood Education vouchers, scholarships, resources
- Impact on emergency housing and transportation
- LEAs that support emergency hotel stays
