Exhibitors may purchase and combine multiple tables. However, table directions may not be changed without prior written consent due to space constraints and fire code. Exhibitors may not share or sub their space with another organization without prior written consent from NAEHCY.

**Electrical connections are available for exhibitor booths for an additional fee. Exhibitors who require power at their booth may purchase electrical service directly through the designated conference service provider.

Due to the inherent nature of coordinating floor space with fire code and other factors, on-site exhibitor registration is not permitted.
